Depart from: Mugg & Bean at White river crossings shopping centre, White River, Mpumalanga.

Estimated return date is 20 days later on 5th March 2020 at Mugg & Bean White river crossings shopping centre.

Companies and individuals are invited to sponsor our charity motorbike rider for each Kilometre done, or 10 km's done, or 50 km's done by Dr Andre on motorbike. Options: R1 per km, R2 per km, R1 per 10km, R1 per 50km completed by PCA rider or straight once of donation of any amount of your choice.

Per km sponsors only pay after the charity ride is complete and when the total km's driven are confirmed on return to the Mugg and Bean in White river Crossings shopping centre.

In the event of the rider having an incident or is forced to abandon the charity drive, sponsors will only pay for actual kilometres done before abandoning the round-trip effort. A photo of the odometer will be taken in such an event at the place where the ride is abandoned.

The odometer reading will be taken down by a nominated party and two witnesses at the start of the charity bike drive event and at the end of the charity drive and photos of the odometer will be taken on both occasions.

The route will reach the most Northern, Eastern, Western and Southern points of South Africa that is accessible by road bike and is approximately 5600 km but may vary if alternative routes need to be taken. It will not exceed 5900 km in total distance driven by our bike rider.

Our rider for this Pediatric care Africa charity ride is Dr J. Andre Hattingh the Founder and Chairman of Pediatric care Africa on a Road King Harley Davidson.

Rider/s will be accompanied by an assistance vehicle carrying, water, food, tent, petrol, spare tyres and will be towing a billboard trailer advertising the event.
