



“On Trac-Tor” for Charity – 6 Provinces Tractor ride ***World record tractor ride 2024***

3500KM by tractor for Charity

Our 3rd annual “On-Trac-Tor” charity tractor ride

Start date: Sunday 21st of July 2024 – Sunday the 11th August 2023

“21 days of sheer determination on a Mahindra tractor”

Aim: To ride through 6 provinces for not less than 3500km km on a Mahindra tractor with trailer as part of our Pediatric care Africa “On-Trac-Tor” 2024 charity fundraising campaign.

Our world record tractor ride attempt, will start at Mahindra Nelspruit on Sunday 21st July 2024 at 09h00 and end at Mahindra in Nelspruit on Sunday the 11th August at about 13h00.

NB: This extraordinary tractor ride is going to happen without a support vehicle and other persons riding with as any form of technical support. Our record attempt will be lodged with RecordSetters in the USA for evaluation/verification and if accepted, they will officiate our record attempt and issue an official world record certificate.

Persons joining the ride on the route for short distances for moral support are allowed and highly encouraged.

This will be Pediatric Care Africa’s 3rd annual “On-Trac-Tor” charity tractor ride.

Since our inception in 2017 we have supplied free medical care to 7849 persons during medical outreaches, 1824 children have seen a private medical practitioner or specialist, 148 children received free surgeries, we distributed 511 000 kg of food parcels, 7243 tins of baby formula and 9098 packets of baby porridge was delivered to children by us.

The purpose of this ride is threefold:

1. To draw international attention to the extremely high number of farm murders and farm attacks in South Africa as the entire farming community in South Africa is affected
2. To collect funds for poor children that require bigger and more complex surgeries.
3. To create awareness on the Shocking levels of violence that continue to destroy children's lives across South Africa, with 285 children murdered and 2,707 surviving attempted murder, assault, or grievous bodily harm between October and December 2023 only. (UNICEF South Africa)

21st July 2024 Sunday: Nelspruit to Burgersfort via Sabie and Lydenburg R537,

22nd July 2024 Monday: Burgersfort to Mokopane (Potgietersrus) via Zebediela R37

23rd July 2024 Tuesday: Mokopane (Potgietersrus) via Bela Bela to Thabazimbi R37, R518

24th July 2024 Wednesday: Thabazimbi to Magaliesburg via Rustenburg R510 & R24

25th July 2024 Thursday: Magaliesburg to Randfontein R24, R28 (3 hours in Randfontein at Mahindra) to Carletonville R559

26th July 2024 Friday: Carletonville to Parys via Potchefstroom R501 & R53

27th July 2024 Saturday: Parys to Welkom via Bothaville R59, R30 (*Stay over x 2 nights*) Note: If required to build up extra km's, ride to Bothaville via Viljoenskroon return to Welkom to make up any possible short fall on total distance of route.

28th July 2024 Sunday: Welkom (Rest)

29th July 2024 Monday: Welkom to Bloemfontein via Bultfontein R710 & R700

30th July 2024 Tuesday: Bloemfontein to Trompsburg R706 & R704

31st July 2024 Wednesday: Trompsburg to Venterstad via Colesburg R717, R58

1st August 2024 Thursday: Venterstad to Cradock R390

2d August 2024 Friday: Cradock to Dordrecht via Queenstown R61 & 392

3rd August 2024 Saturday: Dordrecht to Macleer (*Stay over x 2 nights*)

4th August 2024 Sunday: Macleer (Rest) **Ride the Naude's neck pass up to Elands Height, the 2nd highest gravel road and the 4th highest altitude in South Africa at 2920m altitude.**

5th August 2024 Monday: Maclear to Kokstad R56

6th August 2024 Tuesday: Kokstad to Underberg R617

7th August 2024 Wednesday: Underberg to Nottingham road via Howick R617

8th August 2024 Thursday: Nottingham road to Dundee via Greytown R622, R33

9th August 2024 Friday: Dundee to Piet Retief R33

10th August 2024 Saturday: Piet Retief to eManzana (Badplaas) via Carolina and Amsterdam R33, R36

11th August 2024 Sunday: Badplaas to Nelspruit R38 & R40
